

Immunization Information

IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM SNELLVILLE SCHOOL

ALL STUDENTS MUST HAVE ALL COMPLETED IMMUNIZATIONS IN THEIR FILE IN THE SCHOOL OFFICES BEFORE THEY CAN ATTEND THE 6TH GRADE.

All immunization information MUST be recorded on Georgia Form 3231. A child entering any school in Georgia for the first time must be age-appropriately immunized with all of the required vaccines (DTP, DTaP, DT; Hepatitis B; OPV or IPV; HIB; Measles, Mumps and Rubella or MMR; and Varicella).

***Vision, Hearing and Dental Georgia Form #3300 must also be on file.**

Chickenpox Vaccination: All students entering the 6th grade are required to have 2 doses of the chickenpox (Varicella) vaccination, proof of immunity or documentation of illness.

2nd MMR: All students entering 6th grade must have 2 doses of the Measles vaccine, 2 doses of the Mumps vaccine, and 1 dose of the Rubella vaccine (or proof of immunity against Measles, Mumps and Rubella). Two MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) vaccines fulfill this requirement.

Students from out of state: All students from out of state must have immunizations transferred to Georgia forms 3231 and 3300 and will need to meet all immunization requirements.

STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND SCHOOL WITHOUT THIS INFORMATION ON FILE.

Directions to the Health Department from Snellville Middle School:

- Turn left out of Snellville Middle School onto Pate Rd. 0.3 miles
- Turn right onto Lenora Church Rd. SW 1.7 miles
- Turn right onto Scenic Hwy SW/GA-124 E 6.2 miles
- Turn right onto Gwinnett Dr. SW 0.4 miles
- Turn right into the Kroger Shopping Center. The Health Dept. is on the right.

Certificates of Immunizations may be dropped off in the Elementary School offices before May 20st or to the Middle School office during the summer.
